

Details of request	<p>Trapp Lane is a national speed limit road, which carries a combination of agricultural vehicles (heavy and light), residential vehicles, buses and heavy lorries and wagons. There is also a steady flow of large horse boxes to the equestrian centre just above the Higher Trapp Hotel.</p> <p>The road is heavily utilised as a rat run between the A59 via Sabden and the A6068, with the majority of traffic coming down Trapp Lane, down Clough Lane, left onto the A671 where the traffic then goes onto the A6068 to connect up to the M65/A56 roads at Junction 8. Clough Lane properties open directly onto the carriageway ie no footway. School Lane accommodates an infant school, which only has a pavement on one side (this is often blocked due to parked vehicles).</p> <p>Action here: Improved signage warning of farm vehicles and pedestrians walking in the road. Improved warnings about approaching 20 mph zone of School Lane and Clough Lane.</p>		
Additional comments (site specific)	<p>The existing 20mph signs appear too late for 60mph motorists to slow down before they reach the 20mph zones of Clough Lane & School Lane.</p> <p>The signs are often obscured by overgrown branches or not easy to see day or night due to the tree canopy blocking out light.</p>
